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Measure Savings Methodology

- **Categorization**
 - o Compare to RTF categorizations as a reference
 - o *Are these the "right" categories?*
 - o *Should the Study category be renamed/redistributed?*
 - o *Should other outliers be addressed (like modeled appliances)?*
 - **Interactive Effects**
 - o **Consistency**
 - Review a general rule (>10%).
 - *Can interactive effects be considered generally at the end use level?*
 - o **Simplifications** (Examples)
 - Commercial Refrigeration
 - *How should modeled results be addressed?*
 - Lighting
 - *How should calculated results be addressed?*
 - *What are the Guidelines that should be considered?*
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Documentation **(as time permits)**
